We will have a service dog in our building and it will be important for the entire community to respect the rules and etiquette involved. This dog has been trained to assist a Spaulding student throughout the school day. It is not a pet and **MUST** not be distracted in any manner from concentrating on the student.

Assistance Dogs International – Service Dog Etiquette

1. Do not touch the Service Dog, or the person it assists, without permission.
2. Do not make noises at the Service Dog; it may distract the animal from doing its job.
3. Do not feed the Service Dog; it may disrupt his/her schedule.
4. Do not be offended if the person does not feel like discussing his/her disability or the assistance the Service Animal provides. Not everyone wants to be a walking-talking “show and tell” exhibit.
